ANAPURNA M² Shut Down Procedure (Daily)

- 1. The carriage is at the Home Position (after printing) 'Home side' is the right hand side from the front >>> It is better to check if all the print heads are in good shape (by doing a Prime Test)
- 2. Turn the Lamps 'OFF'
- 3. Let the Lamps cool down (wait for lamp cooling fans to go off)
- 4. Turn the Vacuum 'OFF' (Remove the media from the conveyor belt)
- 5. Push the Emergency Button 'IN'; the power to the engine will be cut
- 6. Switch the six Ink 2-way valves to 'S' position (keep the extreme right valve, the solution valve, to 'I' position)
- 7. Turn the Mains 'OFF'
- 8. Leave the Compressor & Drier 'ON' (if you need to turn the compressor 'OFF', please follow the weekly shut down procedure)

ANAPURNA M² Shut Down Procedure (Between 2 & 14 days)

- 1. The carriage is at the Home Position (after printing)
 - >>> It is better to check if all the print heads are in good shape (by doing a Prime Test)
- 2. Turn the Lamps 'OFF'
- 3. Let the Lamps cool down (wait for Lamp Fans to go off)
- 4. Turn the Vacuum 'OFF' (Remove the media from the conveyor belt)
- 5. Make sure that there is plenty of Cleaning Solution in the Main Tank and an extra 1 litre bottle in stock
- 6. Perform a 'Head Flush' on all the print heads
 - a. Open the Home Cover
 - b. Switch the 2-way ink valves for Black & Cyan to 'S' position
 - c. Open the solution 2-way valve (to 'S' position)
 - d. Push the 'solution valve' switch (on the front side of the carriage, just below the Digital Indication of the Negative Vacuum) with intervals >>> 1 second ON and 4 seconds OFF >>> till you see the cleaning solution coming out of Black & Cyan print heads
 - e. Switch the 2-way ink valves for Black & Cyan back to 'I' position
 - f. Repeat the sequence ii, iii, iv, v for Magenta & Light Magenta print heads
 - g. Repeat the sequence ii, iii, iv, v for Light Cyan & Yellow print heads
 - h. Now, switch all the six 2-way ink valves to 'S' position and press the Flush button for 1 second (cleaning all the print heads at one time)
 - i. Close the Solution 2-way valve (back to 'I' position)
 - j. Clean the residue of the cleaning solution on the print heads (just a gentle tap with a lint free cloth) and clean the base plate
 - k. Turn the Vacuum Gauge to zero
 - l. Push the Red Emergency Button
 - m. Turn the Power Switch 'OFF' (from rear side of the Anapurna)
 - n. Turn the Mains 'OFF'
 - o. Turn the Compressor & Drier 'OFF'

ANAPURNA M² Shut Down Procedure (More than 14 days)

- 1. Follow "Perform a 'Head Flush' on all the print heads" procedures as discussed above in point # 5 of Weekly Shut Down Procedures (till point # k)
- 2. Open the Capping Cover & clean the capping station
- 3. Press CAPPING from the control panel; the carriage will start going up, move towards the left side (capping side) & move down on the caps
- 4. Push the Red Emergency Button
- 5. Turn the Power Switch 'OFF' (from rear side of the Anapurna)
- 6. Turn the Mains 'OFF'
- 7. Turn the Compressor & Drier 'OFF'
